
## Performance Notes & Key for extended techniques:

- Respect time indications for improvised sections.
- Improvise around: Improvise around the provided melody with little restriction. Refer to/ Draw influence from written material but make your own.



**Jaw Vibrato:** Vibrato created by pulling jaw back and tensing. (Technique developed by Tom Jackson).

Wide Vibrato.



**Multiphonics:** Several pitches played simultaneously.

Notes in brackets show prominant additional pitches; those with smaller head show secondary pitches which may also sound.

Fingered Multiphonics: fingerings taken from *New Directions for Clarinet* by Phillip Rehfeldt. Embouchure Multiphonics: produced by fingering unbracketed written pitch and adjusting embouchure

(to include odd partials).





**Slap Tongue:** Produced by puffing short tones with tongue to create a pizzicato effect.






























Serial improvisation: Play pitches whilst maintaing note proximity/ ratio; open meter. Merge into FREE SOLO as suggested.
